Dale W. Meyerrose has more than three decades of business, military, government, and academic experience in cyber integration, telecommunications, information technology, intelligence, command and control operations, and space support. As vice president and general manager for Cyber Integrated Solutions at Harris Corporation, Mr. Meyerrose is responsible for leading all aspects of the company's strategy, research and development, product engineering, sales and marketing, and program execution for cyber growth initiatives.
