Allen L. Krum is the senior executive account manager (SEAM) for the National Reconnaissance Office (NRO) and Special Programs, Government Communications Systems Division (GCSD). In this capacity, he reports to the vice president of Business Development.

Before joining Harris, Mr. Krum served as a consultant to the deputy director of National Intelligence for Acquisition, deputy director of National Intelligence for Collection, and the associate deputy director of Collection for Technical Means, where he helped to establish the new Office of the Director of National Intelligence.

Mr. Krum was a member of the professional staff on the President's Commission on Intelligence Capabilities of the United States Regarding Weapons of Mass Destruction.

Mr. Krum spent 18 years in the Central Intelligence Agency, detailed to the NRO. There he held positions of increasing responsibility, including director of Development Programs, director of Systems Engineering for the Imagery Directorate, and director of the Architecture Group for the Communications and Operations Directorate.

Before joining the CIA, Mr. Krum was a deputy project manager at TRW Incorporated and an engineer at Lockheed.

His military career included 8 years with the U.S. Air Force, where he was a flight operations crew member for a major national security space system and crew chief for ground-based air surveillance and defense systems.
